MEDIA STATEMENT

As part of the \$125 million redevelopment of Gosford Hospital the Kiosk will close on Friday 3 December 2004, with the current food outlets being consolidated.

This closure will coincide with the opening of the new Staff Cafeteria in the new building.

Visitors to the hospital will still be able to purchase food and drinks from the Bayleaf Café located in the Main Foyer area.

A proposal is being investigated to preserve items of historical significance and memorabilia within the structure of the new Hospital, as buildings are closed or demolished.

This will ensure the contributions of the Central Coast community and staff, who have been extremely generous in their donations to the hospital, are preserved.

Due to the increased requirement of staff to run the new Staff Cafeteria, employees who previously worked in the Kiosk will be transferred.

Once the new hospital Main Entrance and Foyer is built, the hospital-run Bayleaf Café and Florist will be relocated.

This is a more central location and easily accessible to all.
