About us: As a respected provider of care since 1933, the Hornsby Ku-ring-gai Hospital is a major metropolitan hospital, and is a teaching hospital of the University of Sydney. In 2007-08 HKHS had 29,907 presentations to the Emergency Department, 1269 births and 14,779 admissions. We have more than 1500 staff members who care for over a quarter of a million people living in the Hornsby Ku-ring-gai area. Our service incorporates six Community Health Centres and ten Early Childhood Centres. We are a sector within Northern Sydney Central Coast Health.
