The ECG Department aims to provide high quality diagnostic cardiac (heart) testing for the Hornsby and Ku-ring-gai areas.

✓ Who are we?

The ECG Department of Hornsby Ku-ring-gai Health Service.

✓ What do we do?

Our service provides diagnostic cardiac (heart) testing for both inpatients (people admitted to Hornsby Ku-ring-gai Hospital) and outpatients (people not currently admitted to hospital) in the Hornsby and Ku-ring-gai local government areas.

We perform restings ECGs, Holter Monitoring, ambulatory blood pressure monitoring for inpatients and outpatients. We also provide stress testing for inpatients.

✓ How you can access our service

A referral from a local General Practitioner is needed for outpatients (people not admitted to hospital). For patients currently in Hornsby Ku-ring-gai Hospital, a referral will be provided by the medical team if needed.
