



Our services: Adult Mental Health



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Hornsby Ku-ring-gai Mental Health service provides a range of mental health services to meet the mental health needs of the adult population the Hornsby and Ku-ring-gai local government areas. We provide mental health assessments, community and inpatient treatment. The service priority is treating people who are seriously affected by a mental health problem or experiencing a mental health crisis.

Hornsby Ku-ring-gai Health Mental Health Service. This includes the Lindsay Madew Unit, on the Hornsby Ku-ring-gai Hospital campus.

✓ [What do we do?](#)

Services include:

- An inpatient treatment service with 25 beds
- A crisis intervention service available 24 hours per day which assesses and treats people living in the area who are experiencing a mental health crisis
- An adult community mental health service providing assessment, treatment and consultation services for people seriously affected by a mental illness
- An aged care mental health service providing assessment, treatment and consultation services for older people seriously affected by a mental illness
- A specialist program for young people with psychosis (Early Psychosis Intervention Service, also known as EPIS)
- A range of mental health rehabilitation services
- Accommodation (group homes) for people seriously affected by mental illness and accommodation problems
